YARD WASTE BURNING, RESTRICTED YARD WASTE BURNING,  
NUISANCE BURNING, BONFIRES AND FIRE PITS.  
(SEE BY-LAW NO. 2017-7 FOR FURTHER DETAILS)**

Individuals who contravene this Burning Ban are subject to a penalty of \$250.00 for the first offence and are also responsible for all cost incurred by the Municipality in fire protection and suppression operations should the fire department be called to extinguish a fire.



### 2018 DUST CONTROL PROGRAM

The R. M. of Oakview will accept requests for dust control application in front of residences and/or established sites within the Municipality on a pre-payment basis. If you are interested in having dust control applied, applications can be picked up at the R. M. of Oakview municipal offices or contact the offices by May 18th, 2018 so applications can be sent out and returned. Applicants will be charged \$200. for a 12' x 300'strip.

Notice is hereby given that a copy of the **VOTERS LIST** may be **revised** at the Oakview Municipal Office at 10 Cochrane Street, Oak River, MB or at the Oakview satellite office at 435 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave., Rapid City, MB during regular office hours between the hours of 8:30 a.m. – noon and 1 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. At these times, an Election Official will be available to update the voters list by:

- (a) adding the names of voters who are entitled to have their names on the list;
- (b) deleting the names of persons who are not entitled to have their names on the list;
- (c) making such other corrections of errors to the list as required.

VOTER ELIGIBILITY  
A person is eligible to have his or her name added to the voters list is he or she is:

1. a Canadian citizen and at least 18 years of age on election day; and
2. a resident of the local authority for at least six months prior to election day OR a registered owner of land in the municipality for at least six months prior to election day.
