Councillor Hyndman reported that the Rapid City Reservoir Committee would like approval from Council as to locations that material could be placed south of the river. Areas available were discussed with Council.

Councillor Hyndman reported on areas for future municipal development and the C.A.O. was instructed to obtain information on land owned by HMQ.

Property standard inspections were discussed. Re-inspections are to be completed at the end of May 2018.

Councillor Hyndman reported on additional information that was received from Municipal Waste Management.

Therefore, be it resolved that the R.M. of Oakview agree to increase the minimum separation distances for siting livestock to two times the provincial land use policy set-back distance and that the Mid-West Planning Board be notified of same".

Revisions to Final Draft of Mid-West Development Plan

Therefore be it resolved that the Council of the R. M. of Oakview request that the following revisions be made to the final draft of the Mid-West Planning District Development Plan:

- 1. That the separation distances between single dwellings and livestock operations remain at 100% great than the mutual separation distances as set out in the Provincial Land Use Policies;
- 2. That the separation distances between designated areas and livestock operations be increased to 25% greater than the minimum mutual separation distances as set out in the Provincial Land Use Policies;
- 3. That the animal cap of 1600 animal units remain.
