## THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF OAKVIEW

## BY-LAW NO. 2015-10

BEING A BY-LAW TO CLOSE A MUNICIPAL ROAD (PUBLIC LANE) AND AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF LAND.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows: 290(1) "Subject to subsection(2), a municipality may close a municipal road by

(a) passing a by-law closing the road;

- (b) obtaining written approval of the by-law from the minister; and
- (c)registering the approved by-law and a plan at the appropriate land titles office."
- 291(2) "A municipality may authorize the sale of land on which was situated a municipal road that has been or is to be closed under Section 290 only with the written approval of the minister."

AND WHEREAS the following described public lane is no longer required for public purposes and it is necessary and desirable and in the public interest that the road be closed;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the R. M. of Oakview enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT all that portion of the Public Lane between First Street and Barrett Street in the L.U.D. of Rapid City, MB in Block 31; Plan 28 in NW ¼ 21-13-19 West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, as same is shown outlined colored Pink on a Plan of Survey made by Vernon N. Hink, M.L.S. of the City of Brandon, in Manitoba, Land Surveyor, on the 15th day of June, A.D. 1992, and registered as Plan Number 28 in the NLTO, be and the same is hereby closed.
- 2. THAT all that portion of the municipal road so closed shall be transferred and consolidated with adjacent existing titles to Murray McCallum 639 Ash Street WINNIPEG, MB R3N 0R3 excepting all mines and minerals, title to which shall remain in the Crown for the sum of \$5,000. (five thousand dollars); and the chief administrative officer of the R. M. of Oakview is authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents required for the transfer. The land transferred
