THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF OAKVIEW

BY-LAW NO. 2020-12

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2018-7 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE CLOSURE OF A MUNICIPAL ROAD AND THE SALE OF LAND.

WHEREAS *The Municipal Act* provides, in part, as follows:

290(1) "Subject to subsection(2), a municipality may close a municipal road by (a)passing a by-law closing the road;

(b)obtaining written approval of the by-law from the minister; and

(c)registering the approved by-law and a plan at the appropriate land titles office."

291(2)"A municipality may authorize the sale of land on which was situated a municipal road that has been or is to be closed under Section 290 only with the written approval of the minister."

AND WHEREAS the following municipal road described below is no longer required for public purposes and it is necessary and desirable and in the public interest that the road be closed;

AND WHEREAS titles have changed since the by-law was passed and therefore the bylaw needs to be amended to reflect the changes;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the R. M. of Oakview enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT the former Clause 2 in By-Law No. 2018-7 be deleted and the following clause be added:
- 2. THAT all that portion of the municipal road so closed shall be TRANSFERRED and consolidated to the adjacent land owner of Lots 1 5, Block 32, Plan A N.L.T.O. as described in Certificate of Title No. 3008548/5 excepting all mines and minerals and other matters as set forth in the Crown Lands Act.
