REPORTS OF COMMITTEES

The Roads and Drainage Committee reported that stripping had been completed in the Krahn pit in the last week of May. A copy of a by-law from another municipality regarding drains and drainage on public/private property was presented to Council for review.

Reeve Fortune reported on the Midwest Planning meeting he attended on June 6th, 2019. The Public Hearing for Oakview's zoning by-law is scheduled for 10:30 a.m. on Tuesday, July 9th, 2019.

Councillor Froese reported on the Local Urban District Committee of Oak River meeting he attended on June 10th, 2019. A public meeting to discuss the possible dissolving of the L.U.D. of Oak River is to be held in September.

RECEPTIONS OF DELEGATIONS

- 1. Melvin Alex, Public Works Supervisor, attended the meeting at 9:15 a.m. He updated Council on unforeseen circumstances that arose in the Rapid City utility when routine maintenance was being completed on the utility. The location of proposed fibre optic cables to be installed in Rapid City was discussed with the public works supervisor as well as an update as to when the new grader should arrive in Rapid City. Stripping completed at the Krahn pit was discussed with the delegate. Road projects proposed for 2019 were discussed and tenders are to be drafted.
- 2. Kerrilee Lapointe, Municipal Assessor from the Minnedosa office, attended the meeting at 10:30 a.m. The impact of the 2020 reassessment for the R. M. of Oakview was reviewed with Council. The impact of the 2020 Reassessment on the property taxes of each class of property in Oakview, as well as the impact on the Municipal Levy of each class of property in Oakview was reviewed with Council. It was noted that the total tax changes (Municipal and School) would mean a single family residential increase 3.9% and farmland increase 1.8% from 2019 to 2020. An open house is to be held in Hamiota on Tuesday, July 9th, 2019 between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. at the Hamiota Municipal Office.

The product is to be applied June 13th and 14th, 2019 in Oakview.

1. Rapid City Utility – Renovations at water treatment plant and waterline replacement.

service deposit and some funding from the municipality if it proceeds;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Council of the R.M. of Oakview agree to fund up to \$25,000.00 from the General Reserve Fund to have Westman Communications Group service all of Oak River with high speed internet, cable TV, and home phone services if the required amount of residents agree to the terms offered by Westman

Communications Group.

Therefore be it resolved that the Council of the R.M. of Oakview agree to contract Ben's Custom Service from Shoal Lake, MB to demolish the buildings; remove cement; and level Lots 60/63; Plan 312 in Oak River as per the request for quote for

the sum of \$4,890.00 plus GST.

2. Gerald Bos – Request to dig through roads 79N and 116N for water pipeline project.

#260/19: Whereas Bos Family Farms is working on a water pipeline project for newly

established pastureland on the N½ of 3-14-20W; N½ of 2-14-20W; and the W½ of 10-14-20W and has requested permission to plough a shallow buried vectorline to supply water for livesteek on each questor:

waterline to supply water for livestock on each quarter;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Council of the R.M. of Oakview authorizes Bos Family Farms to bore through Municipal Road 79N between Roads 116W and 117W and Road 116W between 79N and 78N to install a four inch poly sleeve under the road to pull a 2 inch waterline through and to provide electric fence power

to the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of 10-14-20W and N $\frac{1}{2}$ of 2-14-20W with the following conditions:

1) That all water lines be bored through municipal roads and done in consultation with our public works department so that the road is left in a safe condition;

2) That required signage be used and all Workplace Safety and Health requirements be adhered to.

3. Ben Ledi Ltd. – Request to clean out ditch on 126W between 75N and 74N on east side of road.

#261/19: Whereas Ben Ledi Farms has requested permission to clean out the silt that has accumulated in the east side of the ditch on Road 126W between 75N and 74N as

per levels submitted in writing dated May 28th, 2019;

And whereas approximately 6 inches of material will be removed for approximately 100 yards;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Council of the R. M. of Oakview agree that Ben Ledi Farms Ltd. can clean out the east side of Road 126W between 75N and 74N, at the ratepayer's expense, with the following conditions:

- 1) Approval must be obtained from Manitoba Sustainable Development and a copy of the License filed with the municipality before any work is commenced;
- 2) All work must be done in accordance with the Manitoba Sustainable Development License;
- 3) Any soil removed in contravention of the license will have to be replaced at the expense of the ratepayer;
- 4) That all work is done in a safe manner and the ditch will be left so that it is not hazardous to the public;
- 5) Disposal of dirt, to be put on adjacent landowner property.

4. Mid-West Planning District - Proposed construction of a second single family dwelling on Section SE 28-13-19W.

of the second dwelling will be considered as a permitted use.
