ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

1. R. M. property purchased from tax sale – Tenders have gone out to demolish the house and other buildings. It is hoped that the work will be done before Oak River fair day.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1. Oak River Playground – It was noted that the R.M. of Oakview and the Oak River Playground Committee were successful in obtaining a 50/50 grant from the Building Sustainable Communities Program in the amount of \$24,500. The playground committee had funds over \$12,000. in April. Suggestions as to what playground structures should be installed have been reviewed and quotes from Sourcewell are to be obtained. A meeting with the committee is to be set up as soon as possible. Most of the existing equipment will probably have to be removed.
2. Paving in Oak River – Some cracking in the pavement on South Railway Street was brought to the attention of the office. Zenith Paving was contacted and came out to inspect the area. Unfortunately, due to the fact that it was not dug out, Zenith indicated there was nothing they would do at this time. The paving on the street was done as an additional area and it was thought that the road was in good enough shape for the pavement.
3. Property standards – Commissionaires are being contacted to inspect properties in the village that may be in contravention of the by-law. Work to be done by the municipality was discussed.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Student employment – Some student grants were approved but to date only one green team student has been hired for this side of the municipality. It is hard to get students for the positions. Femka Heijmans is scheduled to start next week.
2. Nuisance birds in the municipality – A concern was received in regards to nuisance birds in the village. The former people who volunteered to shoot the nuisance birds have decided not to continue with the program. The secretary was asked to contact some individuals who may have their PAL and see if they would be interested in volunteering for the position.
3. Retirement of secretary – D. Kuculym announced that she was retiring and this would be her last L.U.D. Of Oak River Committee meeting. C.A.O. Marci Quane will be the secretary at this time.
