

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF OAKVIEW

BY-LAW NO. 2022-5

WHEREAS "The Municipal Act" requires all Municipal Corporations to make estimates of all the sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year in which said sum required to be levied, to pay all its debts falling due within the year, making due for all allowances for taxes to be levied on all lands purchased by the Municipality at Tax Sale and considered uncollectible for the cost of collection and the hereinafter called the Tax Reserve.

AND WHEREAS The Rural Municipality of Oakview has made estimates of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary by By-Law to levy a rate or rates of so many mills on the dollar on all ratable property of the said Municipality liable therefore as the Council deems sufficient to raise the sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation as shown by said estimates.

AND WHEREAS the assessed value of all ratable property within the Municipality of Oakview according to the last revised assessment roll is \$233,194,170.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to set the rates of taxation for the purpose aforesaid and the time of payment of all taxes so levied.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Rural Municipality of Oakview, in session assembled, enacts as follows:

ESTIMATES

1. That the estimates of the Rural Municipality of Oakview of all sums required for the lawful purposes of the Corporation for the year 2022, as set out in attached schedule hereof and identified by the signatures of the Reeve and the Chairman of Finance Committee, be and are hereby approved.
2. That the following respective rates of so much on the dollar be and are hereby levied for the year 2022 upon the assessed value of all ratable property in the Municipality respectively liable therefore according to the last revised assessment roll to raise all the sums required for the purposes of the Corporation as set out in attached schedules Viz:
 - (a) A rate of 8.713 mills on the dollar on the assessable other property in the Municipality for the payment of the 2022 Education Support Levy as set out in letter from the Schools Finance Branch received March 15th, 2022.
 - (b) A rate of 11.114 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the Rolling River School Division special levy as set out in a letter dated March 10th, 2022 on the part of the Rolling River School Division within the Municipality and 9.830 mills on the dollar to provide for the payment of the Park West School Division special levy as set out in a letter dated March 11th, 2022 on the part of the Park West School Division within the Municipality.

- (c) A rate of 8.498 mills on the dollar in Ward 1 to provide for the cost of operating the Local Urban District of Rapid City for the year 2022 to be levied on all ratable property of the Local Urban District of Rapid City in the R. M. of Oakview.
- (d) A rate of 6.655 mills on the dollar in the rural areas of Ward 2 and Ward 3 to provide for the cost of operating in the rural areas for the year 2022 to be levied on all ratable property in Ward 2 and Ward 3 in the R. M. of Oakview.
- (e) A rate of 17.630 mills on the dollar in Oak River to provide for the cost of operating the Local Urban District of Oak River for the year 2022 to be levied on all ratable property of the Local Urban District of Oak River.
- (f) A flat rate of \$85.00 to be levied on all places of residence and businesses within the area of the L.U.D. of Oak River to cover the cost of Garbage collection in 2022 as authorized by By-Law No. 2020-2.
- (g) A flat rate of \$85.00 on all places of residence and businesses within the area of the L.U.D. of Rapid City to cover the cost of garbage collection in the Village for the 2022 year as authorized by by-law No. 2020-3.
- (h) A rate of .650 mills on the dollar to provide for Newdale Hall Area Levy to be levied on the ratable property as set out in a letter from the Secretary of the Agricultural & Community District of Newdale dated March 11th, 2022 and authorized by by-law No. 2020-1.
- (i) A rate of \$96.36 on Rapid City Local Improvement District #3 properties that did not pre-pay the levy to pay the debenture debt charges to hook up to the rural water pipeline as authorized in By-Law #2015-11.
- (j) A rate of \$147.43 on Oak River Local Improvement District # 1 and 2 properties that did not prepay the levy to pay the debenture debt charges for the Oak River utility deficit as authorized in By-Law #2015-12.
- (k) A rate of \$28.62 on Rapid City Local Improvement District #4 properties that did not pre-pay the levy to pay the debenture debt charges for the Rapid City water plant upgrades as authorized in By-Law No. 2021-1.
- (l) A rate of .296 mills on all rateable property within the Municipality to meet the amount required for principal and interest to provide for the repayment of debt for the building of municipal shops in the municipality as authorized by By-Law No. 2021-2.

- 3. That a General Municipal Levy of 5.350 mills on the dollar made up of rates specified in schedules attached and are hereby levied for the 2022 year on assessed value of all ratable property of the Corporation liable therefore to provide for the payments of the amounts estimated for the general purpose of the Corporation Viz: General Government Services, Protective Services, Transportation Services, Environmental Health Services, Public Health and Welfare Services, Environmental Development Services, Economic Development Services, Recreation and Cultural Services, Contribution to Capital, Interest on Bank Loans, Contributions to Reserves and Allowances for Tax Reserve as set out in the attached financial plan.
- 4. That all taxes and rates imposed and levied in the Rural Municipality of Oakview for the year 2022 shall be deemed to have been imposed and levied and to be due and collectable on the 31st day of October, 2022. A penalty of 1.25 % per month to be added to all unpaid taxes as of November 1st, 2022.
- 5. That this By-Law shall be in full force and effective on and from the first day of May A.D. 2022.
